- Humming birds are the smallest migrating birds and the only bird that can fly backwards.
- Ants can be found on every continent except for Antarctica! Can you name all 7 continents?
- Squirrels don't dig up all of their buried nuts which results in more trees.
- Clouds are white because they reflect light from the sun.
- Scat is the scientific term for poop.
- Crows are among the smartest birds in the world and know how to use tools.
- Birds are the only animals with feathers.
- Broccoli is a flower. It is harvested before the flower buds fully open.
- Some grasses, such as bluegrass, are very short. Others, such as giant bamboos, grow as tall as 100 feet.
- Smooth rocks are various stones that are naturally tumbled and shaped by moving water.
- Depending on the species, snails can live 5 to 25 years.
- Thanks to its ability to store water, the cactus can live over a year without rain.
- Some lizards can detach their tails if caught by predators.
- Bees have 5 eyes and 6 legs.
- Rabbits bounce around and purr when they are happy.
- A dog can smell about 100,000 times better than a human.
- All types of animals make burrows: mammals, birds, fish, reptiles, insects, even dinosaurs.
- The word nest can be used as both a noun and a verb, as in a bird nests in a nest.
