San Diego's oldest museum is the newest venue for exquisite private and corporate evening events. With a 90,000 square-foot wing, the museum is an excellent venue for private parties, receptions, fundraisers, gala parties, meetings, and any reason to celebrate. The museum offers event possibilities both inside its new facility and outside on the grounds of the Park.

Spaces include a four-story soaring atrium that can accommodate 2000 guests, a 300-seat, well-appointed theater, a rooftop aerie offering a spectacular city view, a magnificent 8500 square-foot traveling exhibition hall, and a conference room for executive sessions and small group meetings.
