ACCESSIBILITY

All public areas in the Museum are accessible to wheelchairs. There are ramps located at both entrances to the Museum.

ELEVATORS

Elevators to access all levels are located on the North end of the building.

There are two mezzanine spaces that are accessible by a keyed wheelchair lift. The mezzanine spaces are located in Coast to Cactus on Level 2 and Extraordinary Ideas from Ordinary People on Level 3. Keys are available at either Admissions Desk.

WHEELCHAIRS

The Museum has two wheelchairs available for check-out. Wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-serve basis and are only to be used inside the Museum. Please inquire about availability at the Admissions Desk.

SERVICE ANIMALS

Service animals specifically trained to aid a person with a disability are welcome. Pets are not allowed inside the Museum.

GENERAL POLICIES

Food and beverages are only allowed in the Atrium on Level 1. Food and beverages are not allowed in exhibition spaces or the theater.

Personal photography is allowed. Flash photography, tripods, and other large equipment is not allowed.

Free Wifi is available. To connect, go to your device settings and select "Balboa Park".

Cubbies are located at the back of the Atrium on Level 1. If you have a larger item that needs to be stored for the duration of your visit, please visit the Admissions Desk for assistance. The Museum is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Lost and Found is located at the Admissions Desk on Level 1.

Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Strollers are allowed in all areas except the theater. Stroller parking for the theater is located on Level 1. Strollers must remain in your possession at all times unless you are seeing a film in the theater.

Baby changing tables are located in the restrooms on Levels 1 and 2.

Moms can nurse wherever they are comfortable. A suggested location is in The Backyard 5 and under space on Level 1.
