Submission of an application does not guarantee receipt of a scholarship or attendance at a particular program.

Families will be notified whether or not they have received a scholarship within two weeks of submission of an application. Campers will also receive a snack and lunch for each day of camp and a camp T-shirt.

Priority is given to first time applicants. Children who have previously received a scholarship will be placed on a wait list and notified of their standing no later than May 31, 2020.
